

The most recent meeting of the Eastvale Community Meeting began with a representative from Lewis Retail Centers, Kenneth Caron, discussing the new retail center going in at the corner of Hamner and Limonite. Home Depot is scheduled to open on December 18, 2003 and Vons in February or March of 2004. He wouldn't be too specific as to which stores were coming in (little did he know we already knew that information and were discussing in our e-mail group a month ago!) except to say that there were going to be two banks (one is Washington Mutual and we haven't learned the other yet), a 16-plex theater, bookstore, TutorTime, and GNC. The center will open in two phases. Phase 1 will consist of 260,000 square feet and Phase 2 will be underway in December 2004.
