- Each household will need to request at least 1 account (you may add multiple users, each participant requires a personal account)
- JCS D staff will send an account confirmation via email (typically within 1 business day).

### TO REGISTER -

- First time users must sign in from the link provided in the confirmation email

- Click on "View Activities"
- Find the class you are interested in and click the "Enroll Now" button (towards bottom)
- Your selection will be added to your shopping cart, allowing you to enroll in multiple classes or register multiple family members.
- The registration process is complete once you receive a receipt confirmation number

- Log-in and click "Reserve"
- Find the park and shelter you are interested in.

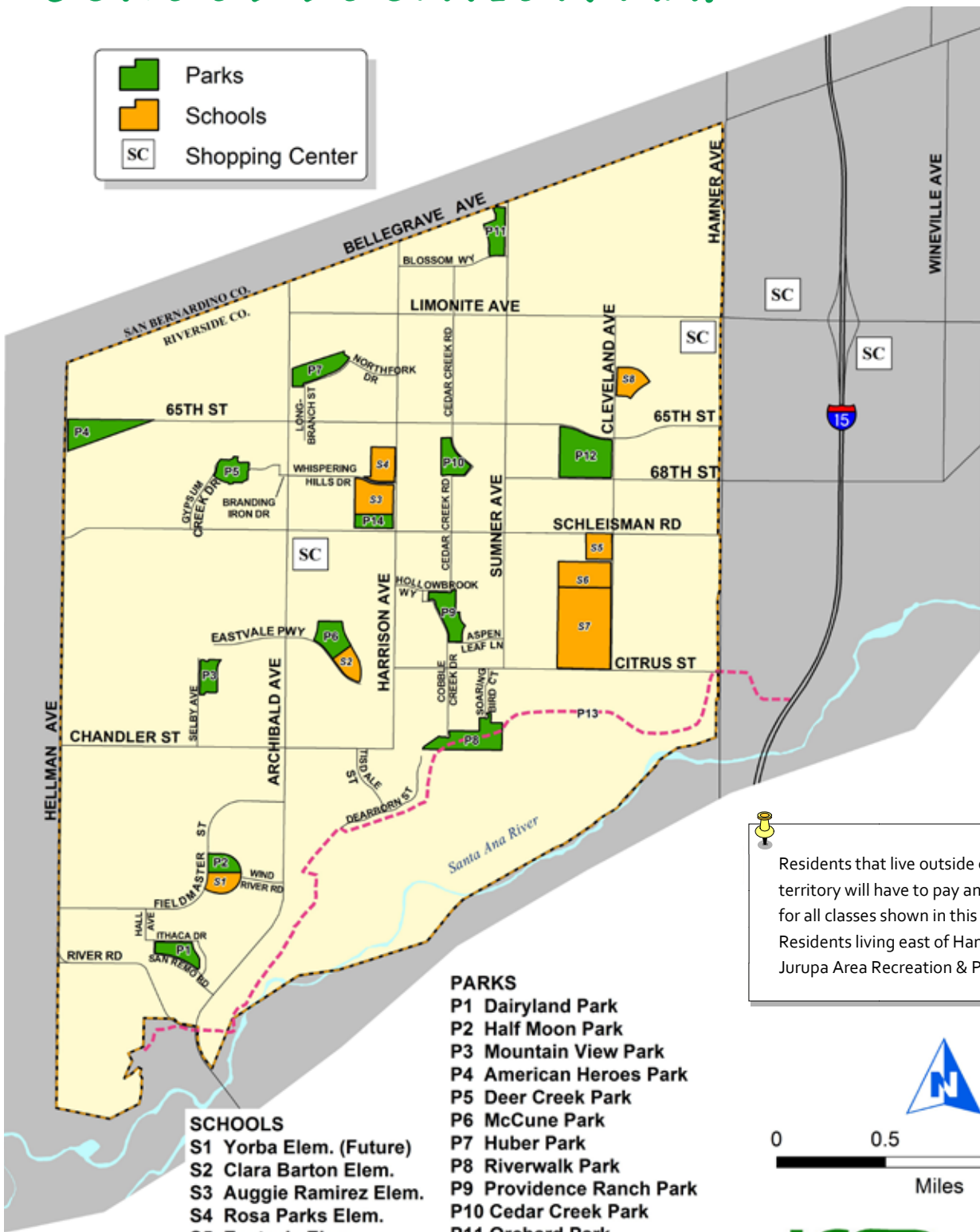



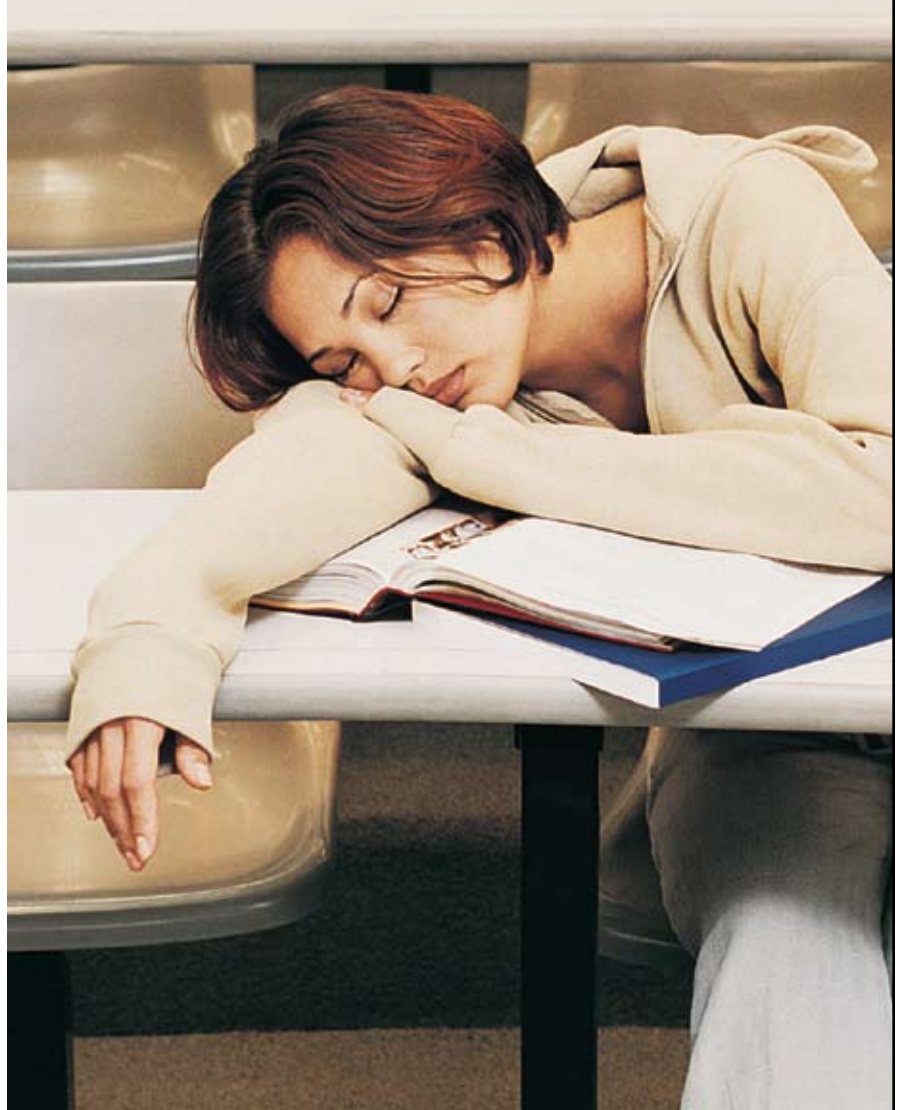
